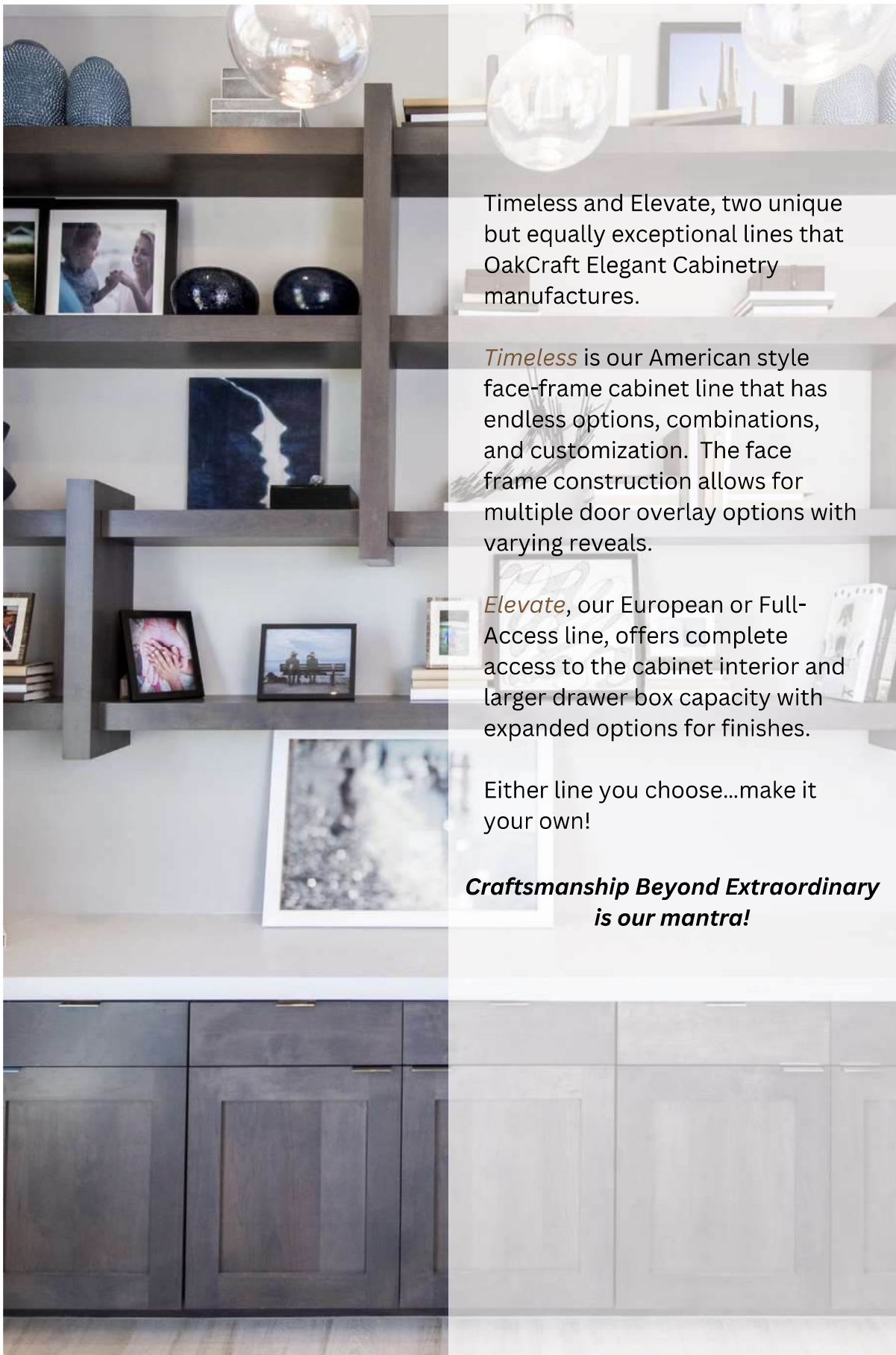

Finish Enhancements



Burn-Thru

Burn-Through is a finish process where the base color is sanded off to reveal raw wood. This is done on the raised details and edges of the doors and drawer fronts only. After this step is completed, the product receives the sealer and topcoat. This technique can be used with a variety of base colors. The overall look varies from door to door as well as on the different colors.



Distressed

Distressing is a process that gives the product a “weathered” look by adding worm holes, rasp marks and dents to the hardwood. All drawer fronts and hardwood parts of doors are distressed. Flat panel doors will receive distressing on the frame of the doors and a light blemish treatment on the insert panel. Moulding and veneer end panels will also receive a light blemish treatment. Wood tops do not receive the distressing treatment. The distressing process is done manually and at random. There is no pattern or template utilized resulting in variances between pieces. Distressing may be done on any wood species. Alder is strongly recommended as the softness of this wood provides a good surface for distressing. The overall look varies from door to door and on the different colors.

Finish Enhancements



Glazed

After the base color is applied, a glaze is applied onto the surface. The glaze is then wiped off, leaving random deposits of glaze in the recesses and details of the wood. The end result of this hand-wiped custom finish is a rich, natural looking “hang up” that accentuates the details of the door design. Due to the hand application, the overall look varies from door to door and on the different colors.

Dry Brush

Dry Brush is a custom hand applied finish technique using brush strokes. The edges are lightly sanded down and the product is applied to the edges and corners of doors and drawer fronts using a brush. This technique creates a feathered appearance that subtly accentuates raised panels, details and edges. For the best look, we recommend this process only on raised panel door styles. This process cannot be customized. Due to the hand application, the overall look varies from piece to piece as well as on the different colors.

ALDER WOOD FINISHES

Alder is very soft and is lighter than most hardwoods. Alder will show scratches and dimples more easily as it is not as dense as the other wood species. For this reason it makes a great wood to distress! Its color is light to medium brown with yellowish or reddish hues. Clear Alder has fairly straight grain and is primarily uniform in texture although it may contain certain small pin knots and mineral streaks. Our knotty Alder doors feature even more mineral streaks and knots of varying sizes and quantity. Alder is porous and soaks up stains and lacquer, which can cause finishes to appear less glossy.

EUROPEAN BEECH WOOD FINISHES

European Beech is a hard, strong, heavy, closed-grain hardwood. This sleek, even textured wood is more dense than either Maple or Oak. It shares the same staining characteristics of Maple, as it accepts a wide variety of stain products. In its natural state, European Beech is predominantly uniform in its blonde color, although minimal variances from heartwood (pale pink-red) to sapwood (white) can occur.

CHERRY WOOD FINISHES

Cherry is a smooth, even grained hardwood known for its warm, rich hues. OakCraft offers it as a “character” species, with enhanced grain and color variation. Cherry can range from deep red to reddish-brown color. In its natural state, Cherry may contain areas that are yellowish, green and even grey. Cherry “mellows” and darkens with age. Exposure to bright or direct sunlight will cause the wood to darken and redden significantly. Cherry will have some sapwood, mineral streaking, fine pin holes and small knots.

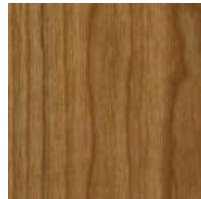

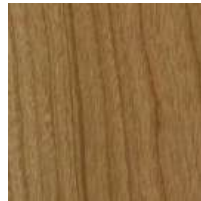

HICKORY WOOD FINISHES

The wild color variation of Hickory makes it a bold and dramatic choice. Hickory is extremely dense which makes it heavy, strong and lasting. Hickory is known as a "lively wood" with its doors being prone to twisting, shifting and moving with temperature and humidity changes. The colors of Hickory range from white to dark brown and may vary with the same piece of wood. Pinholes, knots, burls and mineral streaks are frequent in Hickory and adds to its rustic appeal.

RIFT WHITE OAK WOOD FINISHES

Distinct grain pattern and unique appearance describes Rift Oak. The grain lines run parallel to the board's length, creating a linear appearance. This unique grain pattern is highly sought after for its elegant and refined look. Rift Oak is known for its stability, it experiences less shrinkage and swelling. Rift Oak colors can range from light to medium brown, with an olive cast.

MAPLE WOOD FINISHES

The smooth and clear appearance of Maple is credited to the fine, even grain of the wood. Maple is hard, strong and sturdy, making it a popular hardwood for cabinetry. The wood color can vary from near white to medium brown or reddish brown, and can turn yellow with age. Mineral streaks and pin knots are inherent in Maple and may be enhanced by certain stains or finishes. As a result of the lack of grain, or the closed grain Maple does not stain as easily as other hardwoods.

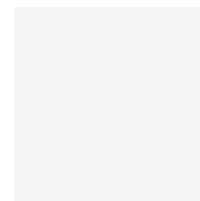

Characteristics: Provided below is an outline explaining some of the most common characteristics in painted finishes that are not considered quality defects. Hardwoods are a product of nature, making it susceptible to climatic conditions, which may cause expansion and contraction. The expansion and contraction is normal and may cause hairline cracks on the joints of the doors and drawer fronts. These cracks are not considered a defect in quality. When exposed to moisture, painted products are susceptible to flaking and more prevalent, cracking. In order to minimize any possible paint failure, the surface must be wiped dry upon contact with any liquids. Try our new HDF painted doors. HDF offers a smooth finish, durability, and stability. Making it an ideal surface for paint.
